Foundational Truth: The Clarity of Scripture

- This morning, the Bible is being taught to adults and children. Not only in Lafayette but across the globe. Not only today but across decades and centuries.
 - Across time, location, culture, and generations... the Bible is understood.
 - Point: The Bible is a **clear Word**.
 - God's truth is able to be understood and known. It is not hidden nor incomprehensible.
 - Qualifications for understanding Scripture...
 - Understanding God's Word will still take time and effort.
 - Understanding God's Word will still take help and resources.
 - Understanding God's Word will still take the help of the Holy Spirit and a willingness to obey.

Arrow 2: "What Did this Passage Mean to Its Original Audience?"

- God had a clear message that spoke to the original audience, and his message still speaks to people today.

- Therefore, to guide our understanding of the Bible, we should make sure that what we think it's saying matches what the original audience would have understood.
- Beyond that, we can also receive a lot of insightful help from others who have done the work.
- Point: Arrow 2 asks, "What Did this Passage Mean to Its Original Audience?"
 - You must develop the skill of **research**.
